Mr Hogan loved visiting our small school to present our Assembly certificates and book awards, and was very interested in our programs that we are running here.



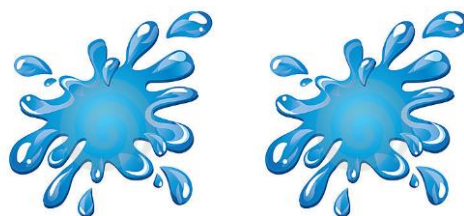
The children also appreciated listening to Mr Hogan speak about his role and his work in Canberra.
